Introduction:

Today, we're taking empty milk gallons and transforming them into delightful piggy pals. With a dash of creativity and a sprinkle of imagination, we'll make these pigs shine at the fair. Let's roll up our sleeves and dive into this exciting project!

Materials that you will need:

- Gallon Milk Jug
- Paint
- Paintbrushes
- Googly Eyes
- Pipe Cleaner
- Construction Paper (Matching the Pig's Color)
- Glue/Tape
- Scissors

Step One:

Remove any labels for the milk jugs.

Step Two:

Paint the milk jug with your paint of choice! Pigs come in all different colors! Some come with spots & some are solid. Design your pig however you like!

Step Three:

Allow the paint to dry completely.

Step Four:

Draw and cut out (2) triangle shapes from the construction paper for the ears.

Step Five:

Glue the googly eyes and ears to the front of the milk jug.

Step Six:

Tape the pipe cleaner to the back of the milk jug for the tail.

Step Seven:

Attach a name tag to the pig listing- the child's name and teacher's name.

Step Eight:

Now, your pig is ready to come to the fair!
