

GGSF **Woolly** Creations- Sheep Craft



Introduction:

Welcome to the woolly world of sheep! In this engaging craft activity, third graders will have the opportunity to create their very own fluffy sheep to display proudly at the fair. These woolly companions are sure to steal the spotlight!

Materials that you will need:

- Empty Toilet Paper Roll (cut in half)
- Construction Paper
- Cotton Balls
- Googly Eyes
- Glue



GGSF Woolly Creations- Directions

Step One:

Cut the toilet paper roll in half.

Step Two:

Cut out two teardrop shapes and an oval shape from the construction paper for the face.

Step Three:

Glue the googly eyes onto the face.

Step Four:

Cut out (4) rectangles from the construction paper and roll each rectangle into a tube shape and glue them together for the legs.

Step Five:

Glue the tubes to the bottom of the toilet paper roll.

Step Six:

Glue the cotton balls to the toilet paper roll.

Step Seven:

Glue the sheep's face to the body.

Step Eight:

Attach a name tag to the sheep listing- the child's name and teacher's name

Step Nine:

Now, your sheep is ready to come to the fair!
